

## Grain Screening Pellets

Grain Screening Pellets (GSP) are the fibrous components of grains made into pellets for ease of handling. Grain Screening Pellets is a good source of degradable protein and carbohydrate in ruminant diets. GSP when competitively priced can be an excellent source of nutrients for growing ruminants. High fiber content makes GSP less valuable for monogastric diets.
